This school in the village of Panimacoc is a bilingual elementary school for children in and around Tecpán. Founded 14 years ago, the school teaches approximately 419 pupils how to better themselves in a country that is marked by poverty and oppression. Due to the fact that the student population has increased year after year, the school has expanded into buildings in three different areas.



As many of the students are Mayan, the students speak both Spanish and Kaqchikel. Volunteers sometimes teach English courses, providing an opportunity for the students at this school to understand a new language that will improve their future employment and education prospects, as well as aid in business opportunities in this agricultural area.

- **Step 3.** Send everyone who donates a follow up 'Thank you' note! If you would like to request a list of donors to know who gave just ask us and we'll be happy to share that information to send 'thank you' notes.
